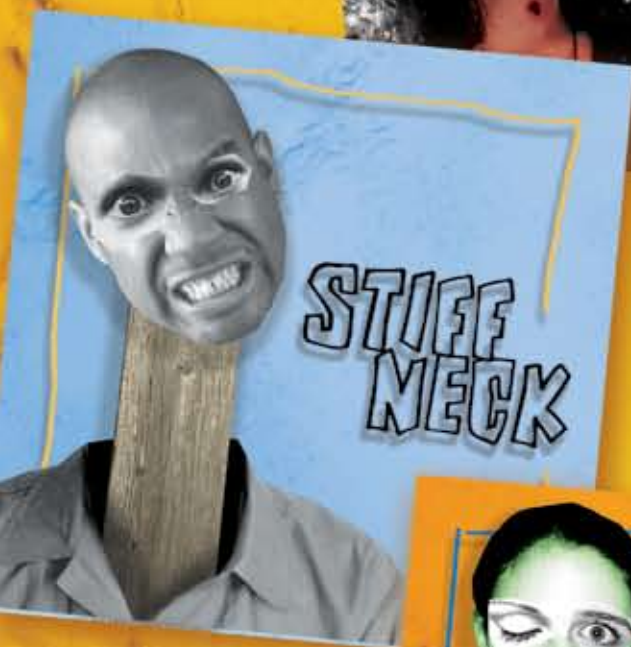


# MENINGITIS
